

English 10: Summer Reading 2018

Central Question: What does it mean to live a Good Life?

All Three Texts are REQUIRED READING

1. *All Quiet on the Western Front* by Erich Maria Remarque.
2. *Never Let Me Go* by Kazuo Ishiguro.
3. *News of the World* by Paulette Jiles.

Please read carefully and critically. Try to pace yourself over the summer so you are not slamming yourself with all three novels two weeks before school. If you have previously read any of the material, you should reread it.

There are film adaptations of *All Quiet on the Western Front* and of *Never Let Me Go*. These can absolutely supplement your reading, but do not use them as a substitute for it.

You are welcome to get the books wherever you like, and any editions (electronic or paper, used or borrowed) are acceptable.

- Any notes you take over the reading can be used on the Summer Reading Exam.
- There will be 2-3 days of review before the Summer Reading Exam.
- The Summer Reading Exam will be over ALL 3 NOVELS.
- The Summer Reading Exam will be on Monday of the second week of classes.
