



9th-Grade Supply List

Art

- Small package of 10-12 wooden pencils
- White eraser
- 5x7 or 6x8 inch unlined sketchbook with name on the front cover

English

- Charged device (not phone)
- Copy of text being studied
- Writing utensil
- Place to record notes, electronically or on paper

Latin II and III

- Spiral notebook OR binder with notebook paper for homework, note taking, and vocabulary
- Any colored pen for grading and annotation
- Folder for keeping returned work

Spanish I

- Notebook
- 3-ring binder or folder
- Writing utensils

French

- Single subject notebook that will stay in the classroom
- Notebook or dedicated section in a binder for notes and practice
- Multi-colored pens or highlighters for marking texts and taking notes

Mathematics

- Graphing calculator (TI 83 or 84 or equivalent) *Cell phones are not allowed as a substitute for a graphing calculator.*
- Notebook or binder with notebook paper
- Pencils
- Red Pens

World History

- Tabbed 3-ring binder with loose-leaf paper (can be shared with Biology or other subjects)
- Notebook for World History use only and a folder

Biology

- 1 box of 50 nitrile or vinyl gloves (labeled with your student name and stored in classroom for labs and dissection)
- Outdoor gear for outdoor work on specified dates (e.g. shoes suitable for hiking/mud, rain resistant jacket, bug spray, sunscreen)

Bring to class daily:

- Laptop (charged and ready to use!)
- Composition notebook (for Biology only)
- Pencil
- Red (or other colored) pen
- Calculator (may be shared with math)
- Binder (may be shared with other classes) or folder
- Water bottle (full of water to keep you hydrated!)

Debate (new teacher so this may change)

- Option A) 1 folder with pockets & prongs
- Option B) 1.5 or 2 inch binder
- *First-time debaters: 1 ream of colored copy paper (can split with classmate)
- *Returning debaters: standard size copy paper or legal size (can split with classmate)
- 1 digital timer (and batteries)
- Colored fine point pens (3 color minimum)

**All written notes and assignments will be done on copy paper, NOT lined paper. Purchasing copy paper is required.*

Choral Music

- Two #2 pencils
- Loose leaf notebook paper
