



## 12th-Grade Supply List

### Advanced Art

- White eraser
- Small unlined sketchbook

### English

- Charged laptop/Chromebook, with Kindle installed/ready
- Copy of text currently being studied
- Pen/pencil
- Lined, college-ruled paper

### Latin IV and V

- Spiral notebook for vocabulary lists and notetaking
- Folder with two pockets for handouts
- Any colored pens for annotating text

### French

- Single Subject Notebook and 2 pocket folder OR a dedicated section in a 3-ring binder if shared with another course

### Spanish

- Notebook and folder
- Pen or pencil in class every day

### Ethics

- Notebook paper for notes

### Mathematics

- Graphing calculator (TI 83 or 84 or equivalent) (may be shared with statistics and genetics)
- Spiral notebook used for this class only
- Graph paper
- Pencils
- Red pen

### Statistics

- Red pens
- Pencils
- Spiral notebook
- A graphing calculator (see math)
- 1" 3-ring Binder with dividers

### Advanced Chemistry

- 3-ring notebook-- Thin -- Recycled is fine.

### Genetics and Biotechnology

- 1 box of 50 nitrile or vinyl gloves (labeled with your student name and stored in classroom for labs)
- Laptop (charged and ready to use!)
- Composition notebook (for this class only)
- Pencil
- Red (or other colored) pen
- Graphing calculator (see math)
- Water bottle (full of water for staying hydrated!)

### Anatomy and Physiology

- 1 box of 50 nitrile or vinyl gloves (labeled with your student name and stored in classroom for labs and dissections)
- Laptop (charged and ready to use!)
- Composition notebook (for this class only)
- Pencil and/or pen(s)
- Water bottle (full of water for staying hydrated!)

### Wilderness Studies

- Permanently bound composition book (wide/college rule - for science class only)
- Black pens and pencils
- 3-ring binder & loose-leaf paper (may be shared with other classes)
- Backpack
- Shoes suitable for hiking & mud
- Rain & wind resistant jacket
- Life Jacket (personal flotation device)
- Fishing Pole
- Paddle Board, Canoe or Kayak (optional)

## **Space Science**

- Blue pens
- Red pens (for annotating your work)
- Pencils
- Hand-powered pencil sharpener (Sturdy, metal ones usually work the best.)
- Coloring markers or pencils
- Composition book
- Plastic filing envelope (for storing worksheets)
- Glue stick
- 30cm ruler (1-piece sturdy, transparent rulers are the best.)
- 1 eraser
- 1 pair of scissors (Sturdy, quality scissors with cutting blades that aren't too small.)

*Optional: a wristwatch (Wristwatches are recommended for getting to classes on time!)*

## **ESL**

- One composition notebook - sewn binding, not glued - to be used for ESL Only
