## Art

- Small package of 10-12 wooden pencils
- White eraser
- $5 x 7$ or $6 \times 8$ inch unlined sketchbook with name on the front cover


## English

- Charged device

## Latin II and III

- Spiral notebook OR binder with notebook paper for homework, note taking, and vocabulary
