



## 7th-Grade Supply List

### Art

- Small package of 10-12 wooden pencils
- White eraser
- 5x7 or 6x8 inch unlined sketchbook

### Pre-Algebra

- Graphing Calculator (TI 83 or 84)
- Notebook paper
- 1.5"-2" 3-ring binder, D-ring recommended for stability
- 1 set of dividers

### Algebra I

- Graphing Calculator (TI 83 or 84)
- Graphing Paper
- Notebook paper
- 1.5"-2" 3-ring binder, D-ring recommended for stability
- 1 set of dividers

### English

- One composition notebook - sewn binding, not glued - to be used for English Only
- Space in a 3-ring binder (consider at least 1.5" if sharing with another course) and 2 tab dividers
- Pens and Pencils
- Yellow, Green and Orange highlighters
- One large eraser

### Latin 7

- Composition notebook OR spiral notebook for homework, notetaking, and vocabulary
- Red pen for correcting work
- Folder for keeping returned work OR a pocket in a spiral notebook

### Science 7

- Blue pens (comfortable to write with)
- Red pens (for annotating work)
- Pencils
- Hand-powered pencil sharpener (Sturdy, metal ones usually work the best.)
- Coloring markers or pencils
- 2 composition books (one for each semester)
- 2 plastic filing envelopes (for storing many worksheets)
- Glue sticks (about 4 large ones or 8 small ones)
- 30cm ruler (It's important that the ruler shows the cm or mm scale. Please don't buy a ruler that folds or is too flexible. 1-piece transparent rulers are the best.)
- 1 eraser
- 1 pair of scissors (Sturdy, quality scissors with cutting blades that aren't too small.)
- a 36" x 48" trifold display board (You don't need to purchase this until the 3rd or 4th quarter. It's for the science fair.)

*Optional: a wristwatch (Recommended for getting to classes on time!)*
