### <u>Art</u>

- Small package of 10-12 wooden pencils
- White eraser
- 5x7 or 6x8 inch unlined sketchbook

- Middle School Planner that offers a section for writing daily assignments and also a monthly overview.
- Notebook paper
- 3-ring Notebook
- Pencils & blue/black ink pens

- Red pen for correcting work
