

Participating in community service is an important part of Seabury life. Service connects students to the local and global community. It creates a stronger personal identity and integrity, and it brings the student body together. Service projects also introduce students to important social issues and give them the chance to make a difference in society. Ideally, students who experience community service in school will continue to be involved in their communities as adults.

Community service requirements begin <u>at the point of enrollment</u>; students who enroll after 6th grade have their requirements "prorated" based on enrollment date.

### Seabury Service Requirements:

- Middle school students are encouraged to perform at least 20 hours of community service each year.
- High school students are **required** to perform an average of 30 hours of community service each year. High school students **must** complete 120 hours of community service before graduation in order to receive their diploma.

Students are encouraged to perform community service each school year. Here is our recommended schedule:

Grade	Hours Earned
6th Grade	20 hours
7th Grade	20 hours
8th Grade	20 hours
Total	60 hours for middle school
Freshman	30 hours
Sophomore	30 hours
Junior	30 hours
Senior	30 hours
Total	120 hours for high school

Students enrolled at Bishop Seabury Academy are encouraged to make service a regular practice **<u>through the course</u>** of their academic career. At whatever point a student enrolls is when the accumulation of hours begin.

Service projects can be of the student's choosing and can include service work at Seabury, in Lawrence, or in the larger state, national, or international community. A project will count toward a student's community service hours **IF** the work is not for self-benefit, involves no payment to the student, and is not required by a teacher, parent, or other authority. The project must also be considered appropriate by the school's Service Coordinator.

Students are encouraged to keep current with their community service hours; no student will receive a diploma until his or her service obligations have been met. Middle school students who demonstrate exceptional commitment to service will be acknowledged at the Academic Awards Ceremony each year.

Service hours must be entered in a timely manner and within the current academic year in order to be credited to the student. All service must be completed, and hours submitted, by Stepping Up of the school year in which the work was performed. Any service completed over the summer will count for the following school year.

In addition to the regular service requirements, seniors complete a **Senior Service Project** before graduation. That project is approved by the Senior Project Coordinator and must be completed before graduation in order for a student to receive their diploma.

Students and their parents should visit the Community Service link on Seabury's website for more details and for frequently updated information about service opportunities.

The **Gavin Smith Service Award** is given to a senior who exemplifies what it means to "promote a sense of responsibility for self and respect for others as members of the community." That student will have:

- Completed the required amount of service hours upon graduation
- Completed a senior project and turned in their reflection
- Shown leadership in service projects throughout their high school years at Seabury
- Aided the service coordinator(s) in organizing projects
- Been a leader in getting younger students involved in service

### How students can check their community service hours:

- Go to FACTS SIS (RenWeb)
- Select "Family" in the list of options on the left side of the page
- Choose the student from the drop down menu at the top of the Family page (top middle of the page on a computer screen)
- Service hours should be one of the info boxes on the screen




### 4. If you've never logged in before: Click on Create New Family Portal Account

Make sure you select "Student" on the three options below the password box.



Community Service How-To Explanation

- Submit your Community Service Form & Guidelines
   Any project, local or international, will count towards Community Service hours if it fulfills all the following requirements:
  - It is not for self-benefit including work done for a grade, financial benefit, or material benefit.
  - · Community Service hours must be an activity that addresses a social or civic issue or a professional area of interest.
  - It requires more than 30 minutes to complete.
  - It requires suitable effort or engagement.
  - The action is approved by the Community Service Director.
  - · Each service effort must be submitted via the Community Service Form on this site. All fields must be completed.
  - Seniors who graduate without completing 30 hours of service total for each of their years at Seabury will have their diplomas withheld until those hours are accomplished.

You will need to provide an email address for an adult who was on-site with you who can testify to your work. The Community Service Director will enter your hours.
