## Seabury Dance Code of Conduct: FRONT PORCH OUTDOORS

- 1. Students must check in with Ms. Czarnecki upon arrival and provide the \$5 fee.
- 2. No student may enter the dance 45 minutes after it begins.
- 3. Once students leave, they may not return.
- 4. Students must remain in the areas enclosed by the traffic cones on the porch area and may not go into the parking lot beyond the cones or into any other part of the campus unless accompanied by a chaperone.
- 5. Students who wish to use the restroom may do so in Reese Hall. Students may refill water bottles or cups in the Commons. The only entry and exit will be through the main doors to the school. The hallway to rooms 218/219 and admin wing is off limits.
- 6. All food and drink consumption must take place outside.

## 7. OFF-LIMITS AREAS.

- a. Classrooms and offices including admin wing
- b. Hallways and Commons with the exception of using the restroom or water fountain
- c. Parking lot and all other areas outside of the traffic cones including the practice fields
- d. All areas in the "old" main building (300 rooms), the gym, and the locker rooms.
- 8. Students may bring one non-Seabury guest to the dance but will be responsible for that guest's conduct while on school grounds.

- 6. On the dance floor or elsewhere, students should refrain from any physical behavior that would be considered inappropriately sexual or obscene.
- 7. Seabury code of conduct as explained in the Community Handbook applies in all situations, as do consequences. Most importantly, no student should ever possess, use, or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at a Seabury event.
- 8. No wheeled things in the dance area or parking lot during the dance (rollerblades, hoverboards, skateboards, etc.)
- 9. Students must make prior arrangements with parents for pick-up. Chaperones cannot be responsible for transportation after the event, including travel arrangements with other students.
