Expectations for Parents and Caregivers:

- If you receive an email from a teacher or administrator, please do respond within a day--that is a signal that we need your involvement!

Expectations for Students

- Plan to attend every day unless you're excused by your teacher
- Your success will depend on open, consistent communication
- Respond to any email from a teacher or administrator as soon as possible, and at least within one day.
- Your parent and teacher must give permission for use of texting
- Check your email several times a day, and know what your teacher plans to use for communication if it's different
- Ok to get up, walk around, get a snack etc. Talk with your teacher about their expectations
- Go to advising, clubs, etc.
