All items listed below are REQUIRED READING

1. *Green Grass, Running Water* (Canadian 1993) by Thomas King + resource materials Dr. Eicher will provide in July.
2. *Winter's Bone* (American 2006) by Daniel Woodrell
3. *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time* (British 2003) by Mark Haddon.

Please read carefully and critically. Try to pace yourself over the summer so you are not slamming yourself with all three novels two weeks before school. If you have previously read any of the material, you should reread it.

For *Green Grass, Running Water*, I will be sharing links to resources to help you understand key elements of the book (unless you are already an expert on *Moby Dick* and the works of James Fenimore Cooper). These are materials you will need to read/listen to before the first day of class.

You are welcome to get the books wherever you like, and any editions (electronic or paper, used or borrowed) are acceptable.

- Any notes you take over the reading can be used on the Summer Reading Exam.
- There will be 2-3 days of review before the Summer Reading Exam.
